



Definition of what constitutes an Aiki Kai Australia class

Summary:

In general, if a class takes place at a location, specific time and with an instructor, all authorised by Aiki Kai Australia (through the local Area Representative), then it is recognised as an official class for grading purposes.

Specific requirements:

1. Is an Aikido class
2. The dojo or location has the approval of and is registered by the local Area Representative
3. Is run by an Instructor authorised by Aiki Kai Australia to do so
4. Is open to all Aiki Kai Australia students to attend
5. Is advertised to all the relevant students
6. Has a class fee being paid to the local State / Territory Association
7. Has a formal record of attendance kept using a method that is approved by Aiki Kai Australia
8. Has a duration of at least one hour
